



St Katharine Docks, in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, were one of the commercial docks serving London, on the north side of the river Thames just east (downstream) of the Tower of London and Tower Bridge. They were part of the Port of London, in the area now known as the Docklands, and are now a popular housing and leisure complex.

The existing wooden decking area on the Coronarium Bridge located at St Katherine's Dock had become slippery particularly when wet.

We were advised that the client require an anti-slip system installed onto the wooden decking areas which would not affect the overall appearance of the original wooden decking.

Richco recommended the application of our Wood-Deck System applied directly onto the fully prepared wooden decking areas to provide a decorative anti-slip finish.

The finished wooden decking area met with the client's requirements by providing a decorative anti-slip finish which did not affect the overall appearance of the wooden decking system.
